NEW BUSINESS:

• **Contracted Dance Teacher**: *Thien Hua* - part-time during the school day as part of 100 minutes of P.E. required by the state. At \$40 per hour; 5 hrs/wk for 10 weeks = \$4000. Program offers enhancement to P.E. classes, the opportunity to engage in physical activity, express creativity, and build teamwork. For 3rd-5th grade per week (TK-2nd are covered by funds from Prop 28). Trial program will be good demonstration. **Amy B.** motions to approve \$4000; **Katie** seconds; majority approves. Can use spend down, after school program.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Katie Hansen (H/Os: 'Statement of Activity 7/1/2023-1/24/2024,' 'Budgets vs. Actuals' dated 7/2023-1/2024, 'Treasurer Report-2023-01-24')

- Art Sale, Dine to Donate are contributing to the well-being of the budget.
- **Pledge Drive**, not as successful as past two (record) years, but better than average, and there are more monthly donations this year that continue to accrue funds.
- **Investment Account**: passively brings in \$~600/month.
- **Surplus**: Staffing \$18K under budget, funds budgeted for after school programs not used due to lack of staffing, teacher grants usually claim about ~75% of what is budgeted.

TEACHER'S REPORT: Sierra Hill

- **Wellness**: Coming back from holidays would be great to have PPE no longer funded by the government: kid-sized disposable masks, large sanitizer bottle, tissues. Some classes get it donated by parents. **Jenna** motions to approve up to \$1000; **Katie** seconds; majority approves. Maybe from Central Warehouse or McKesson so that everything is uniform. **Amy B.** will check in with Nurse Jackie.
- TWI/Dos Alas Promotion: would like banner & schwag/t-shirts.
- **Spirit Wear**: Less expensive, more accessible t-shirts. Buy-one/give-one or Scholarship (based on teacher recommendation) option. Will ask Bridget Olp; may have a flash sale to get a larger order.
- End-of-Year Celebration: Amy is collaborating with Shuntelle and will send further information.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Thien Hua

• After Care Transportation: Boys and Girls Club is starting a shuttle van and had to prepare with training protocols as a non-profit from De Laveaga February 5; they are trying to prioritize for neediest families. Lack of bus drivers and liability restrictions are also an issue. Service on Metro will expand to all users as part of a federal initiative. Jacob mentioned many individual cars taking kids to a variety of locations (Happy Quails, Ramblin' Adventure Club). CKC and Parks & Rec pay a facility fee for use of the campus after school.

VPs' REPORT: Jenna Branecki, Juliana Reyes

• **Popcorn Fridays**: new equipment is very efficient and there are plenty of volunteers.

- **Movie Night**: Late February/early March. **Amy B., Maestra Cardenas**, **Lisa Price** are collaborating with Student Leadership.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Amy Bosch

- **Owl Camera**: Didn't need to approve because there is already a line item; only being used by monthly fee for Spanish translation, website hosting/domain a year from June. At least \$1200 should be available under Office Expenses > Equipment/Software.
- **Dia del Niño Talent Show,** April 27: **Jacob** looking for the best way to collaborate with ELAC; FEB meeting will overlap and **Amy B.** will also open a new e-mail chain to help solidify plans.
